Monday 27th February is a Teacher Training Day and the School will be closed on this day.




STRIKE ACTION

<u>Thursday 2nd March – Information for parents</u>

It is World Book Day on Thursday 2nd March and this is how we will be celebrating at Cambois Primary;

Book Tokens and Books:

We have collected a range of books using the book tokens and will be handing these books out to the children on the day.

"Read where you please" challenge:

Over the half-term holiday, we would love to see the places where you love to read. Take a picture of yourself reading in a curious/adventurous/unusual place. I will be sharing these in an assembly on World Book Day. There will be a prize for the most adventurous photo for EYFS, Y1-2, Y3-4 and Y5-6. Parents can email in the photo to admin email account no later than Wednesday 1st March at 9am.

Story-time:

Each class teacher will be picking a story to be shared with children in the afternoon. They are going to "pitch" this book during the assembly. The children will then get to choose which teacher they would like to go and listen to share their story and will go to that class in the afternoon.

<u>Pupil Voice – What we've read so far:</u>

During World Book Day the children are going to express themselves and talk about their love of the books and texts we have shared so far this year. They can compare and link these to stories they already love and we will be sharing a school display to celebrate the stories and love of reading.

Book Swap:

Children can bring in a book from home that they no longer read and bring it to a shared table in the hall. At the end of the school day, those children can return to that table to see a full selection that they can swap their books for a new book.
