Can you help your grown-up put away the washing? You could match the items of clothing to their owner or see if you can match pairs of socks.

Make a musical instrument using an empty box or tub and dried pasta or lentils or by wrapping elastic bands around an empty shoe box. Then have some fun playing in your new band.
