### SCHOOL LUNCHES

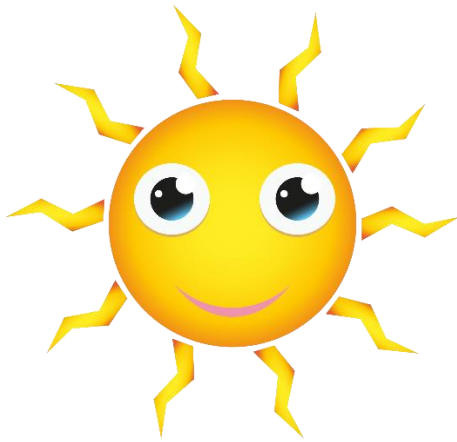
